



### Road Safety policy

1. The safety of our children will always come first. Our most important priority is to prevent the death or injury of a child while in our care.
2. If out and about with children on foot, we will always prioritise walking safely, in line with the latest safety advice.
3. When transporting pupils by vehicle during educational activities/trips, we will always prioritise doing so safely. It will be the parent's responsibility to ensure the safety of their children, including ensuring seat belts are worn and fastened appropriately at all times whilst travelling by bus.
4. We will model good practice road safety within the setting that is age appropriate for the children in our care.
5. We will get involved in useful awareness-raising initiatives that promote road safety in our wider community, such as Road Safety Week and Beep Beep! Day for pre-schoolers.
6. We will aim to improve the safety and environmental standards of transport to and from our premises, by having a School Travel Plan that aims to reduce the use of cars. This will also improve the safety and wellbeing of children on foot or bikes.
