

**Maths & Numeracy**

Children will develop their understanding of shape, space, and number. They will explore and compare 2D and 3D shapes, identify their properties, create repeating patterns, and build models. Children will develop place value knowledge by counting, reading, writing, and representing numbers, understanding how numbers are made up of hundreds, tens, and ones. They will use concrete and pictorial resources to partition, compare, and represent numbers, and use correct mathematical language to describe size, quantity, and position.

**Humanities****Being****READY, RESPECTFUL & SAFE**

Children will learn about kindness, fairness, and making good choices. They will explore how people can live kindly and responsibly, care for others and the natural world, and understand right and wrong. Through stories, discussions, and caring activities, children will learn about rules, fairness, helping others, and how actions can affect people and the environment.

**Cymraeg**

Children will be encouraged to use and enjoy the Welsh language through daily routines such as Slot Drilio, Helpwr Heddiw, Criw Cymraeg, and our Patrwm yr Wythnos. They will practise simple Welsh phrases and take on roles to build confidence, independence, and pride in using Welsh as part of everyday school life.

**Expressive Arts**

Children will develop their digital skills by using cameras and iPads to take photographs for different purposes, such as shape hunts, school trips, outdoor learning, and construction creations. They will record sounds to support storytelling and retell familiar stories. Children will also learn about staying safe and responsible when sharing images and videos, linking to their health and wellbeing.

**Language, Literacy and Communication**

Children will develop their language and literacy skills through Talk for Writing using The Three Little Pigs, innovating the story to write their own version based on an under-the-sea theme. They will explore and use new vocabulary, sequence and map stories, and learn about story structure using a story mountain. Children will begin to develop reading behaviours through guided reading, take part in daily phonics sessions, practise handwriting in a multisensory way, and read regularly with individual reading books to build confidence and fluency.

**Science and Technology**

Children will be learning about living things, including plants and animals. They will explore how living things grow and change, what they need to survive, and how they can be grouped and sorted. Children will learn about different parts of plants and animals, life cycles, habitats, food chains, and how living things depend on each other within an ecosystem.

**Health and Wellbeing**

Children will learn how to build positive relationships, show kindness and respect, and value differences between themselves and others. They will develop emotional literacy by recognising, expressing, and managing their feelings, understanding mental health, and knowing when and how to seek help. Children will learn how to stay safe, make sensible choices, and understand rules and responsibilities. They will also explore how to care for their bodies through healthy eating, physical activity, and understanding how their bodies grow and change.
